

Proxies are allowed under guidelines established by the county by-laws. These are the rules governing proxies:

- Person carrying proxy must be registered to vote in the same precinct as the absent committeeperson, and must not be a member of the County Committee.
- Person carrying proxy must carry a picture ID.
- Proxy must be written in ink and witnessed. Notarization is not required. The proper form is provided below. (Rule 21.5)
